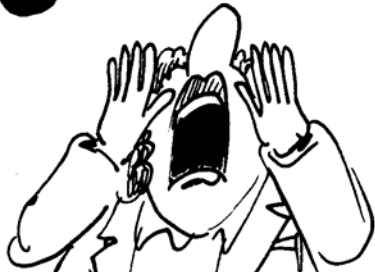

Volunteer Opportunities

Affiliate Committee: (For Affiliate members only)

Promotes the affiliate members of the board, establishes ways to better serve the Affiliate members. Funds and sponsors board events. Plans Networking events. Meets Monthly

Education Committee:

Plan and provide relevant, fun and convenient Continuing Education programs. Provide New Member Orientation classes. Meets monthly on Mondays at 9am.

Finance Committee:

Prepares a balanced budget which funds all programs approved by the Board of Directors. Oversees the assets of the Board and Investments. Meets at least twice a year.

Horse Show Committee:

Sponsors a Horse Show at Medina Fairgrounds to promote the REALTOR® image in the community and to generate non-dues income for the Board. Meets monthly January thru June.

Housing Opportunities Committee:

REALTORS® are committed to providing fair housing, creating affordable housing, reaching out to the less fortunate. The Housing Opportunity committee informs members about fair housing issues, developing programs for housing affordability and working with community housing organizations.

Legislative Committee:

Monitors local, state and national issues. Conducts local candidate interviews. Meets monthly.

Program Committee:

Plans, carries out and promotes the meetings and social events; including the four general membership meetings, and the annual Chilly Cookoff/Reverse Raffle. Meets Monthly.

American Home Week R.A.T.

Plans content and works with a local paper to publish the American Home Week Tabloid Section in April. Meets Feb-April

Awards R.A.T. (must be a previous MBOR Award Winner)

Reviews Award Applications and selects Award winners based on Nominations submitted. Meets once or twice in the sprint

Bowl a Thon R.A.T.

Plans and carries out the Annual Charity Bowlathon event held in July. Meets April-July

Bylaws R.A.T.

Reviews and amends the governing documents of the Medina County Board of REALTORS® including the policy manual and the bylaws. Meets as needed

Golf R.A.T.

Responsible for organizing the Annual Golf Outing in June. Will meet monthly from March-June or as needed.

RPAC Committee:

REALTORS® Political Action Committee conducts the annual RPAC fund raising drive for the year. Informs the membership on the importance of contributing to this fund. Meets monthly January thru May

Technology Committee:

Reviews, maintains and updates all technological functions of the Board, including computerized internal operations, web site maintenance and NAR/OAR Communications information. Meets when needed
